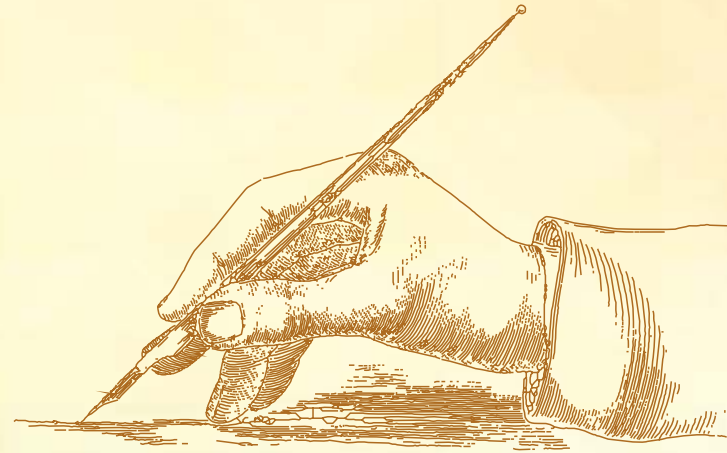

THE PARENT BODY

Calicut Islamic Cultural Society (CICS) was established in 1977 with the sole purpose of commitment to the education, social, economic, and moral advancement and rehabilitation of the weaker sections of the society. The society is recognized by the Government of India, the Government of Kerala and the Central Wakf Council.

The main campus of the society is at Sneha Nagar, Kolathara, Calicut with an area of eleven acres of land, just ten kilometers away from Calicut city. The society has another campus at M.G. Nagar, Mathara in Olavanna Grama Panchayath (comprising an area of 16 acres) which is about eight kilometers from the city. Peekay CICS Arts and Science College is one of the institutions functioning under CICS.

The CICS is successfully running the following projects under the leadership of Jb. P.K. Ahammed and Adv. M. Mohamad.

ABOUT US

Peekay CICS Arts and Science College, a self-financing college affiliated to the University of Calicut situated on the sprawling sixteen-acre campus at the green heights of Mathara, was established by the Calicut Islamic Cultural Society (CICS) in 2013. The college was formally inaugurated by Dr. M.K. Muneer, Minister for Social Welfare and Panchayat on 20th August 2014 and Padma Shri M.A. Yusuf Ali was the Guest of Honour.

Initially, the Calicut Islamic Cultural Society (CICS) which runs many institutions, had applied for an Arts and Science College at Mathara as per the decision of the Executive Committee meeting held on 21st July 2009. However, the request was not considered by the University. Subsequently, in the same year, the Peekay Educational and Charitable Trust under the Chairmanship of Jb. P.K. Ahammed had applied to start a college at Nallalam, Calicut and the University of Calicut had considered their request. However, due to some technical reasons, the Trust was not able to start a college as planned. It was then in 2010 that the Peekay Educational and Charitable Trust started Peekay College of Arts and Science in the hostel building which was partially vacant at M.G. Nagar, Mathara owned by the CICS under the principalship of Prof. M. Mohammed Basheer. The repurposed hostel building is the present Galadari Memorial Block (Old Block) of the college, donated by Abdul Rahim Ibrahim Galadari, UAE.

In 2012, Peekay Trust put forward a proposal to transfer the college to CICS. At the Executive Committee meeting of CICS on October 18, 2012, it was decided to take over the college. However, as per the Calicut University statute, there was no provision or clause to transfer a college under a Society/Trust to another Society/Trust and thus CICS couldn't take over the college. Later at the Executive Committee meeting of CICS on 25th October 2012, it was decided to apply to start a new college. Thus emerged Peekay CICS Arts and Science College which was then approved and sanctioned by the Government of Kerala as per order no: G.O. (Rt.) No.1273/2013/ H.Edn. Dt. 22.06.2013. Prof. M. Mohammed Basheer was the first Principal of Peekay CICS Arts and Science College for the period from June to September 18th, 2013. Prof. A. Kuttialikutty, former Principal of Farook College, assumed the office of the Principal on 19th September 2013 and he continues to date. Notable developments have taken place on the campus in the last ten years. It is noteworthy that a strong foundation has already been established by Peekay College of Arts and Science led by Jb. P.K. Ahammed which has provided a solid footing for the growth and success of Peekay CICS Arts and Science College.

The college commenced its operation with 66 students enrolling across three programmes: B.Com Finance, B.Sc. Computer Science, and BCA. In 2014, it expanded its offerings to include BBA, BA in English, and B.Com CA. B.Sc. Psychology was introduced in 2015, M.Sc Psychology in 2019, followed by B.Sc Maths in 2020, and M.Com in 2021. Additionally, B.Com Taxation was introduced in 2022. The college has applied to start a new programme, B.Sc. Applied Statistics with Data Science as a complementary subject in the next academic year. Currently, there are 1243 students enrolled, supported by a dedicated team of 51 teaching staff and an additional 20 supporting staff.

The campus saw considerable development in the infrastructure facilities within a few years. The transformation of an old boys' hostel into classrooms marked an early developmental phase, complemented by the immediate acquisition of a college bus for student transportation. Over the years, the campus underwent substantial infrastructural enhancements, including the construction of a New Block, Cafeteria, Huddleroom, NSS room, and Sports room, along with additional facilities for Computer labs, a Psychology lab, and a Counselling Centre. The College Library has a collection of more than 3600 books and subscribes to 22 periodicals. There is a spacious auditorium and the playground has ample space for diverse sports activities.

Peekay CICS Arts and Science College boasts a vibrant campus life, featuring various clubs and facilities. The establishment of the NSS unit in 2016, along with clubs such as the Media Club, ED Club, Red Ribbon Club, Readers' Forum, Nature Club, Fine Arts Club and Quiz Club, contributes to the holistic development of the students. To look into the grievances of female students and women members of the staff there is the Women's Cell. The Old Students' Association (FOPCA) inclusive of the former students of Peekay College of Arts and Science plays an active role in the welfare of the students and the college.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell, proposed by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is functioning actively under the guidance of the Principal and experts and members from the teaching and administrative staff. The PTA promotes activities for the well-being of the students. The students are offered Add-on courses–RUTRONIX which is authorized by the Government of Kerala. Moreover, the timings of the college from 9 am to 2 pm is conducive for students to take up part-time jobs. The talented students are placed in reputed companies under the training and guidance received from the Career Guidance and Placement cell.

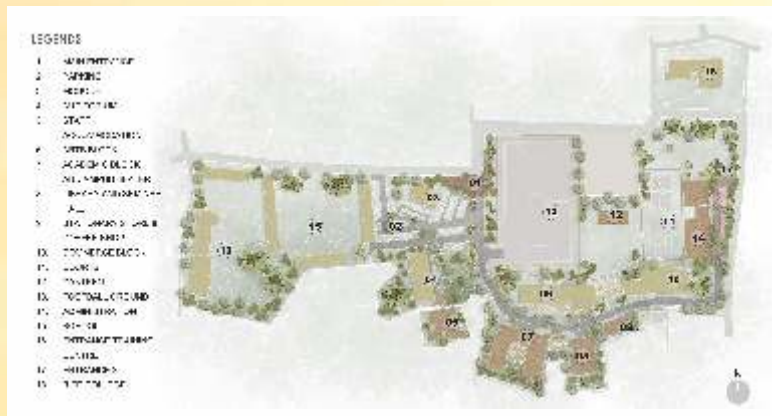
Students have left an indelible mark in various cultural and sporting events, showcasing their talents and achievements, including active participation in the B Zone festivals and Inter-Collegiate competitions. Beyond the campus, numerous social service initiatives extend the college's outreach to the wider society by actively participating in humanitarian activities such as blood donation drives, collecting clothing for the underprivileged, providing food kits, and visiting the homeless and the destitute. Engaging in activities under the banner

of Campuses of Kozhikode and SIPC, the college moulds students into socially responsible individuals.

As the college marks the decennial year, it is notable that the college has carved a distinctive niche in the temple of fame among all other self-financing institutions under the University of Calicut. The college's progress is evident through its diverse array of programmes, like conducting university-level competitions, seminars and workshops. Further more, the first-ever Graduation ceremony for M.Com and M.Sc Psychology took place on November 30, 2023.

The college is also gearing up for the two-day National Seminar on 21st and 22nd Feb. 2024, with eminent personalities as resource persons. Overall, the college campus fosters excellence, creativity, and holistic development. The college is moving ahead and ready to scale greater heights with the embellishment of the campus soon.
