
**Functions of the SEDGs Cell**


1. To identify and support students from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds.
2. To implement UGC-mandated initiatives such as bridge courses, mentoring, earn-while-learn schemes, and peer support.
3. To maintain and review records of students availing such support.
4. To ensure a discrimination-free, inclusive, and safe academic environment.
5. To conduct awareness programs, orientation, and workshops on inclusive practices.
6. To report periodically to the Principal and academic council on the progress and challenges faced by SEDG students.
7. To provide a platform for grievance redressal related to discrimination or marginalization of SEDG students.
